Pre-K 4 SA's Sixth Annual Gracias San Antonio Art Exhibit and Auction to Benefit ChildSafe Four-year-olds create art, learn civic engagement, and participate in cultural life of San Antonio

WHAT: The *Gracias San Antonio* Art Reception is the culmination of Pre-K 4 SA's yearlong civic engagement program. Pre-K 4 SA students worked with prominent local artists to create pieces of art inspired by the children's explorations of the city. The art pieces will be auctioned to support ChildSafe with a goal of raising \$20,000.

Gracias San Antonio: Children Are Citizens Project is grounded in the belief that children are not just future citizens, but are citizens of the city today. *Gracias* engages the 4-year-olds to express their opinions and participate in the civic and cultural life of San Antonio. As citizens of the community, the students also learn to give back to their city.

ChildSafe was chosen as the benefiting charity by students in a vote held at the four Pre-K 4 SA Education Centers on Nov. 5 to promote Election Day. Throughout the year, children and families engaged in City Explorations by visiting different places around San Antonio. Local artists joined students in the classroom to create authentic art pieces using a variety of artistic media to express the children's perspective of their city and the places visited. More than 100 pieces have been created and will be displayed at the gallery on opening day.

"One of the primary goals of Pre-K 4 SA is to create a strong, educated workforce in San Antonio. Through our civic engagement initiatives like *Gracias*, our children and their families have the opportunity to engage with the community and experience what makes San Antonio a unique and vibrant city," Pre-K 4 SA CEO Sarah Baray said. "Integrating the arts into the early childhood curriculum enhances the children's learning and development."

About Pre-K 4 SA:

Pre-K 4 SA is a comprehensive early childhood initiative aimed at changing the education and workforce trajectory of San Antonio in one generation. Pre-K 4 SA offers full-day pre-kindergarten for 4-year-olds living in the City of San Antonio. Pre-K 4 SA is free for qualifying students and also accepts tuition-paying students. The school day begins at 8 a.m. and ends at 3 p.m. Extended hours are available at no additional charge from 7:15 to 8 a.m., and from 3 to 6 p.m. for working families. Breakfast, lunch and two snacks are included and free transportation is available to all students. Pre-K 4 SA has four Education Centers located throughout the city: North Education Center, 3635 Medical Dr.; South Education Center, 7031 S. New Braunfels Ave.; East Education Center, 5230 Eisenhauer Rd.; and West Education Center, 1235 Enrique M. Barrera Memorial Parkway. The Pre-K 4 SA Professional Learning program provides pre-kindergarten through third grade educators in San Antonio with complementary continuing education to support best practice instruction to help every child in San Antonio excel. The Pre-K 4 SA Competitive Grants program provides more than \$4 million in funding annually to increase quality and access in early childhood programs throughout San Antonio.
