Pre-K 4 SA and HOLT Group Break Ground on New South Education Center to Address Child Care Desert

SAN ANTONIO — [February 27, 2024] In a significant stride towards addressing the early childhood education needs of San Antonio, <u>Pre-K 4 SA</u> and <u>HOLT Group</u> broke ground today on a new state-of-the-art early learning center that will serve as the new South Education Center. The new center is slated for completion by the summer of 2025.
