## PRE-K 4 SA ENROLLMENT FOR THE 2025–26 SCHOOL YEAR OPENS ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 1 AT 8 A.M.

**(SAN ANTONIO)**–Enrollment for Pre-K 4 SA, San Antonio's premier early childhood education initiative, opens on Saturday, February 1 at 8 a.m. Children must be 3- or 4- years old by September 1, 2025, to be eligible to apply for the 2025–26 school year. Applications can be submitted online at <u>prek4sa.com</u> and are processed on a rolling basis.

Pre-K 4 SA offers a comprehensive program with many benefits for families:

- Free full-day pre-kindergarten
- Breakfast, lunch, and snacks included
- Free transportation for all students
- An extended day learning program is available for qualifying families
- Tuition assistance and scholarships are available for families who do not qualify for free pre-k through Texas Education Agency (TEA) guidelines. A <u>scholarship calculator is</u> <u>available on the website</u>.

The program has four Education Centers located throughout the city:

The Pre-K 4 SA Open House event will be held at each Center on Friday, January 25. It will be an opportunity to learn more about the program, meet with teachers and staff, engage with our innovative programs, and build community with potential classmates and families.

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Pre-K 4 SA is a comprehensive early childhood initiative aimed at changing the education and



workforce trajectory of San Antonio in one generation. Pre-K 4 SA offers full-day prekindergarten for 3and 4-year-olds living in the City of San Antonio. Pre-K 4 SA is free for qualifying students and accepts tuition-paying students. Breakfast, lunch and two snacks are included and free transportation is available to all students. Pre-K 4 SA has four Education Centers located throughout the city, and the Gardendale Early Learning Program, the first Pre-K 4 SA innovation site, was made possible through a partnership with Edgewood Independent School District.
